



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GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- English (4 credits)
 - 9th Lit & American Lit (required)
- Math (4 credits)
- Science (4 credits)
 - Physics (or Physical Science); Biology; Environmental or Chemistry
- Social Studies (3 credits)
 - World History, US History, Economics/Am. Gov't
- Health/Personal Fitness (1 credit)
 - *JROTC (3 years = exempt from H/PF requirement)
- CTAE Electives (3 credits)
 - Fine Arts
 - World Language (2 credits needed for 4-year colleges)
 - Career Tech
- General Electives (4 credits)

Total: 23 credits (In the respective subject areas above)

NOTE: Your student can earn a total of 32 credits due to our SHS block scheduling.

PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

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
9th Grade to 10th Grade: 5 credits

• 2 ELA, 2 Math, 2 Science, + 5 other credits 11th to 12th grade: 16 credits


 Able to graduate by end of the school year

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Opportunity for HS students to take college-level courses and earn credit toward a high school diploma and a college degree at the same time

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WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

11th or 12th grade- must meet the requirements of the specific college

The program is FREE and does not count against HOPE money after graduation

Students may attend either part or full-time, and can earn up to 30 credits

Students can go to 2- or 4-year colleges

Check with specific colleges to see preferences between DE and AP classes

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Where to Find Dual Enrollment Information:

- Go to <u>www.sprayberrycounseling.com</u>
- Click on "Dual Enrollment"
- Complete all the required steps and submit the paperwork to counseling
- You must complete Advanced Algebra and American Literature before you start the DE program
- You will be responsible for all deadline dates (the college and high school deadline dates are often different)

ADMISSION EXAMS

- ACT
- SAT
- ACCUPLACER
- ASVAB

- Students must self-register for the ACT, SAT, ACCUPLACER, ASVAB, etc.
- How?
 - Go to: www.SprayberryCounseling.com
 - Click on the 12th grade tab
 - Click on "SAT/ACT Information"
 - Click on the SAT or ACT link

FEE WAIVERS:

- If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, you are eligible for 4 total fee waivers.
 - Two (2) SAT waivers
 - Two (2) ACT waivers
- Once you sit for the SAT or ACT, you will also qualify for college application fee waivers.
 - It is the responsibility of the student to obtain the application fee waiver from the college.

NOTE: Sprayberry's College Entrance Examination Board # (CEEB) is: 112005.

Test Optional

Freshman Index: Includes high school grade point average and test scores for either the SAT or ACT.

Test Optional: Use the high school grade point average on the required high school curriculum without a standardized test score at the following minimum grade point averages:

- 3.4 for research universities: Augusta University and Georgia State University
- 3.2 for comprehensive universities: Kennesaw State University, Georgia Southern University, University of West Georgia and Valdosta State University
- 3.0 for state universities: Abany State University, Clayton State University, Columbus State University, Fort Valley State University, Georgia Southwestern State University, Middle Georgia State University, Savannah State University and the University of North Georgia



The student must bring in their SS Card to the Counseling Office so that it can be added to the student system.




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THE COMMON APP.

0 What is the Common Application (Common App.)?

 Common App is nonprofit membership organization representing nearly 900 diverse institutions of higher education. They connect applicants and those who support them to a wide array of public and private colleges and universities across all 50 U.S. states, and 20 countries.


 If you choose to use Common App, you will need to match it to Naviance. Counselors only use Naviance to send college material.



Steps to Match Common App Account

- Create Common App account at www.CommonApp.org
- Add at least ONE college you are applying to in 'My Colleges'
- Under 'Education' tab, add <u>Sprayberry High School</u> and complete all information under this tab, then click SAVE
- Return to 'My Colleges' tab, click the dropdown arrow of the school and click on 'Recommenders and FERPA'
- Read, complete, and sign

After this is complete, return to Naviance Student account to match Common App.


Naviance is a college and career readiness software provider that partners with high schools and other K-12 institutions to provide students with college planning and career assessment tools.

+ 0 Naviance From School

- Log into the school computer
- Open Google Chrome (this is the preferred browser for Naviance)
- Go to <u>www.cobbk12.org</u>
- Click "Find it Fast" in the top right corner
- Click "Naviance" on the right-hand side, 4th button from the bottom
- You should be taken to your Naviance student homepage automatically

+ Naviance From Home

- Open Google Chrome (this is the preferred browser for Naviance)
- www.cobbk12.org/sprayberry
- Click on "Menu" on the left-hand side
- Click on "Resources," then "Academic" then "Naviance"
- Click on Student or Parent
- Students log in using your Office 365
 Username and Password (this should be the same as how you access a school computer)




How to complete the "Brag Sheet" for the Letters of Recommendations

- Go to your Naviance Account
- Click on "About Me"
- Click on "Surveys from your School"
- Under "My Surveys" click on "Senior Brag Sheet for Letter of Rec"
- Tell us all about you! The more you "brag," the better your LOR
- Click "Update" when completed
- Teachers and counselors will use this information when you request the LOR

How to add colleges you are applying to

- Go to your Naviance Account
- Click on "Colleges I'm Applying to" on the home page
- If you are applying through Common App you will want to match the accounts first and your colleges will automatically pull over to Naviance
- For additional colleges not through Common App, click on the blue plus sign to add colleges



How to request an LOR from a specific teacher

- Go into your Naviance account
- Click "Colleges"
- Click on "Letters of Recommendation"
- Click "Add Request"
- Select your teacher from the drop-down menu
- Select the name of the college in which the LOR should be sent
- Include a personal note for the teacher
- Click "submit request"

When requesting the LOR

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Make sure you student gives the teacher a minimum of 2-4 weeks to complete the request 2

Your student needs to ask the teacher, in advance, for the LOR

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
Once completed, your student needs to send a thank you note to the teacher

Requesting a Transcript

- Go
 to: www.sprayberrycounseling.com
- Scroll down to "Official Transcript Request"
- Click on the "here" link
- Directions for how to request and pay for a transcript are listed there
- Each transcript cost \$2.00
 - Payment via Cash or MyPaymentsPlus

Register for College Visits!

- Go to your Naviance account
- Click on "Colleges" at the top
- Click on "College Visits"
- Click the "Register Now" button
- Students will receive an email confirmation they can use for a pass to show their teacher.
- College visits are every Tuesday from 10:00- 10:45 am or 2:15- 3:00 pm. It will be different colleges in each time slot.
