## What is GPA?

* Grade Point Average (GPA):

| $A=4.0$ | $90-100$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| $B=3.0$ | $80-89$ |
| $C=2.0$ | $74-79$ |
| $D=1.0$ | $70-73$ |
| $F=0.0$ | 69 and $\downarrow$ |

- Different kinds of GPA
* Weighted vs. Unweighted
* Cumulative vs. Core
* HOPE
- College


## How do I calculate a GPA?

- Step 1: Assign each grade a numeric value
* $A=4 \quad(90-100 \%)$
* B=3 (80-89\%)
© C=2 (74-79\%)
* D=1 (70-73\%)
* $\mathrm{F}=0 \quad$ (0-69\%)

AP and honors courses earn quality points<br>$\mathrm{AP}=+1$ quality point<br>Honors $=+0.5$ quality point

* Step 2: Add the numeric point value

Step 3: Divide by the total number of credits attempted

## GPA Examples

## Example 1

Algebra I - B = 3.0
World Geography $-\mathrm{A}=4.0$
Intro to Drafting - B = 3.0
Art $-B=3.0$
$3.0+4.0+3.0+3.0=13$
$13 / 4=3.25$ GPA

## Example 2

H Algebra - C = 2.5
H World Geography - B = 3.5
Intro to Drafting - B = 3.0
Art $-\mathrm{A}=4.0$
$2.5+3.5+3.0+4.0=13$
13/4 = 3.25 GPA

## Why take Honors and AP classes?

Provides opportunities to improve study skills

* Familiarizes you with college level work
* Can boost your cumulative GPA

Prepares you for big tests (ACT, SAT, ASVAB, Accuplacer, Milestones)

* Gives you an advantage in college admissions
* Allows you to expand your interests
* May be eligible for college credit (AP Exam)
* Improves work ethic and critical thinking skills for workforce

BUT... you must find the right balance for YOU; don't compare yourself to others

- Foundations of Algebra counts as a $4^{\text {th }}$ math requirement for graduation only

## What if I Fail a Class?

If it is required for graduation, you must repeat and pass the course

You will need to retake the course in summer school
If you fail gh $^{\text {th }}$ Literature, Math, Science, OR if you do not earn
5 credits, you will not be promoted to $10^{\text {th }}$ grade
Failing grades stay on your transcript. After you retake the course the new passing grade will be added to your transcript.

## Dual Enrollment (DE)

DE is a state funded program that allows
$11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ graders to take college
classes while completing their high
school diploma.

Any $10^{\text {th }}$ grader can take CTAE classes at a Technical College


DE pays for $100 \%$ tuition, mandatory fees, and required textbooks up to a maximum cap of 30 hours
